Background Information:

Beast Master is a fun game that can be played with four or more participants! You can either try this game at home, or in a large group over a zoom meeting!

Follow the instructions on the next page to see if you've got what it takes to become the next "Beast Master"!

- 1. Choose one person in your group to be the Beast Master and have everyone else line up facing that individual.
- 2. The goal of this game is to become the Beast Master by beating the current master.
- 3. There are four animal shapes that you need to know.
 - Eagle: stand with your arms held out to your sides like wings
 - Snake: position one arm in front of your body like a snake head
 - Rabbit: make ears with your finger above your head
 - Bear: make bear claws with your hands







- 4. The Beast Master will turn around and give everyone a chance to secretly choose one of the four animal choices to show/become.
- 5. The Beast Master will then count down from three and turn around, showing one of the four animal shapes.
- 6. When the Beast Master turns around, all the other players must freeze in the animal shape that they have chosen.

- 7. If anyone chose the same animal as the Beast Master, they are out. (e.g. you decided to show a Rabbit, and the Beast Master did too). If you are out, take a seat.
- 8. The game continues until there is only one person left to face off against the Beast Master.
- 9. The final person will stand back-to-back with the Beast Master. For this final showdown, the last person standing must beat the current Beast Master three times in a row to become the new champion. This means that they must choose an animal that is different from the Beast Master's animal three times in a row! If, at any time during this showdown, they choose the same animal as the Beast Master, they are defeated.
- 10. Play as many rounds as you'd like!

Feel free to create four of your own animal shapes to play with.
