Manic Math Game

Instructions:

- 1. Have both players face each other, either seated or standing.
- 2. Each player puts one hand behind their back and chooses a number to show on their fingers.
- 3. Count down from three, and have each player show the number they were holding behind their back.
- 4. The first player to correctly add up the total between the two numbers is the winner.

For example, if one player chose '4' and the other chose '3', the first to say '7' would be the winner.

5. Play continues to a designated total score (or for however many rounds the players want to play).
